3 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application is DENIED.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED as follows:

5 1. The Regents of the University of California is authorized, through its
6 lawful agents and/or representatives, to take any and all actions reasonably necessary to lawfully
7 enforce any and all orders of this Court relating to that area commonly known as the "Memorial
8 Stadium Oak Grove" and any other property or properties of the University included in any such
9 orders.

10 2. In seeking to lawfully enforce any such order or orders of this Court, the
11 University shall take such precautions as reasonably necessary to prevent endangering the life
12 and/or safety of others including, but not limited to, any individual occupying any property or
13 properties included within any such order or orders.

14 3. The denial of food and/or water to anyone, while that individual is
15 occupying any property or properties included within the coverage of any of this Court's orders
16 relating to any property or properties of the University, shall not be considered a violation of this
17 order.
